

COVID-19 Passenger Vehicle Disinfecting Protocol

In the case where van use is required/approved, we need to recognize that the passenger van/vehicle is a confined space with many touch surfaces, and therefore requires proper disinfection.

Cleaning and disinfecting of the vehicle should be performed before and after each use.

Using BETCO DAILY DISINFECTANT DUAL or FIGHT BAC RTU, clean and disinfect:

(Reminder, these products have a 10 minute contact time-surface must stay wet for 10 minutes to ensure proper disinfection by spraying product onto a clean cloth and applying to the surface)

1. Door handles
2. Seat arm rest
3. Grab bars
4. Seat belt latches
5. Steering wheels
6. Drivers' controls
7. Dashboard
8. Any easily reached touch surface from the passenger seats
9. Vehicle Keys/Fob

Disinfectant wipes should only be used for electronic components, key remotes or surfaces that would not tolerate a liquid spray. (Follow the contact time on the container)

Ensure the following items are kept in the vehicle at all times:

Hand sanitizer

Gloves

Tested Daily Disinfectant Dual or Fight Bac RTU with clean cloths/paper towels

Disinfectant Wipes

Reminder: Physical distancing between driver and passenger is required (as far apart as possible).
