



Return to Work Guidelines for Staff Who Have Had a *!High Risk Exposure" To

A Person with Symptoms of Illness, Or a Person With a Known Case of Covid-19 or Any Other
Communicable Disease.





Return to Work Guidelines for Staff Who Is Positive for COVID-19



- Able to continue to work if asymptomatic or can return to work if they have no fever and other symptoms have been improving for 24 hours (or 48 hours if vomiting/diarrhea)
 - Must follow *** Measures below for 10 days from positive test result or symptom onset

***Measures

- Wear an N95 mask in the presence of other staff or PWS (i.e., not eating meals/drinking in a shared space) for 10 days from symptom onset or positive test.
- Strict adherence to mask and hand hygiene is extremely important.
- Work in only one facility/location, where possible for 10 days after date of specimen collection or symptom onset (whichever is earlier) in order to prevent transmission across the setting, as much as possible.
